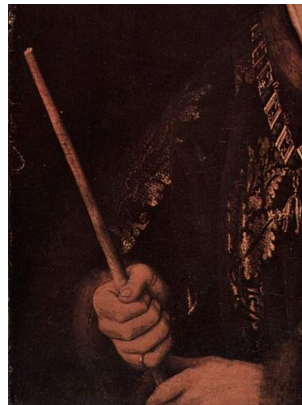

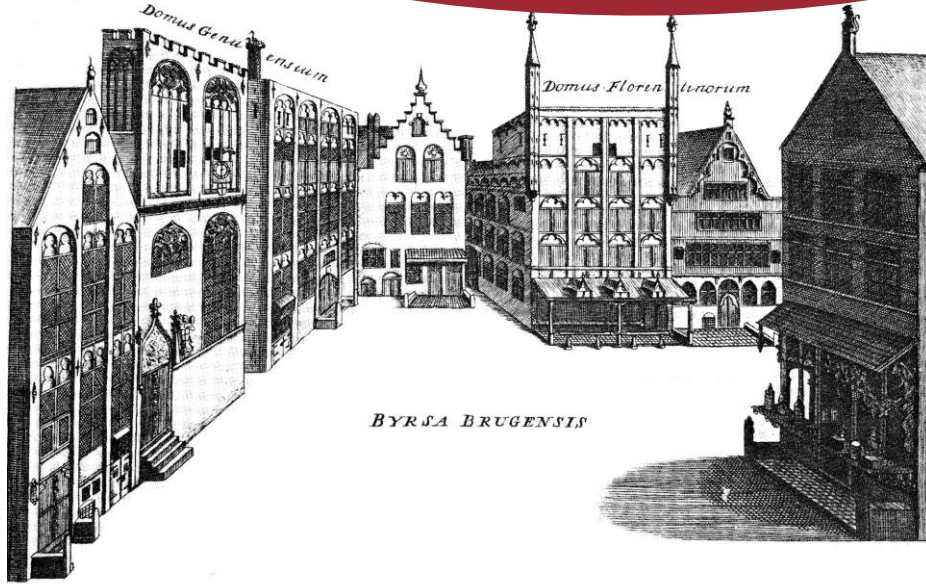

Time to move on, because we are still missing a piece of the painting...



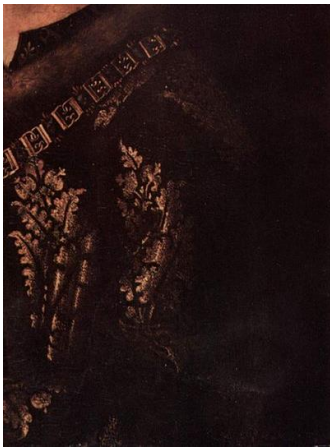


Our search continues in the streets of Bruges.

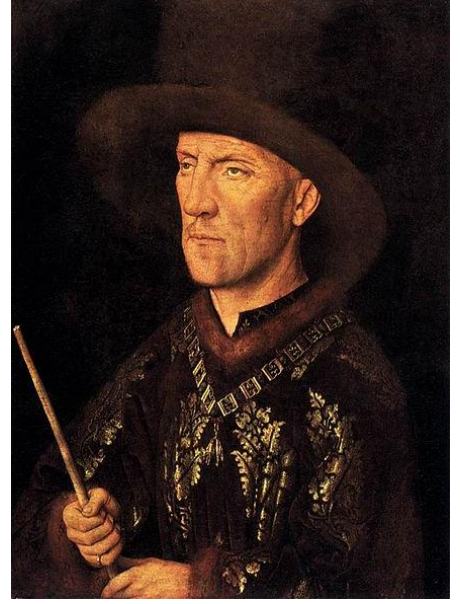
