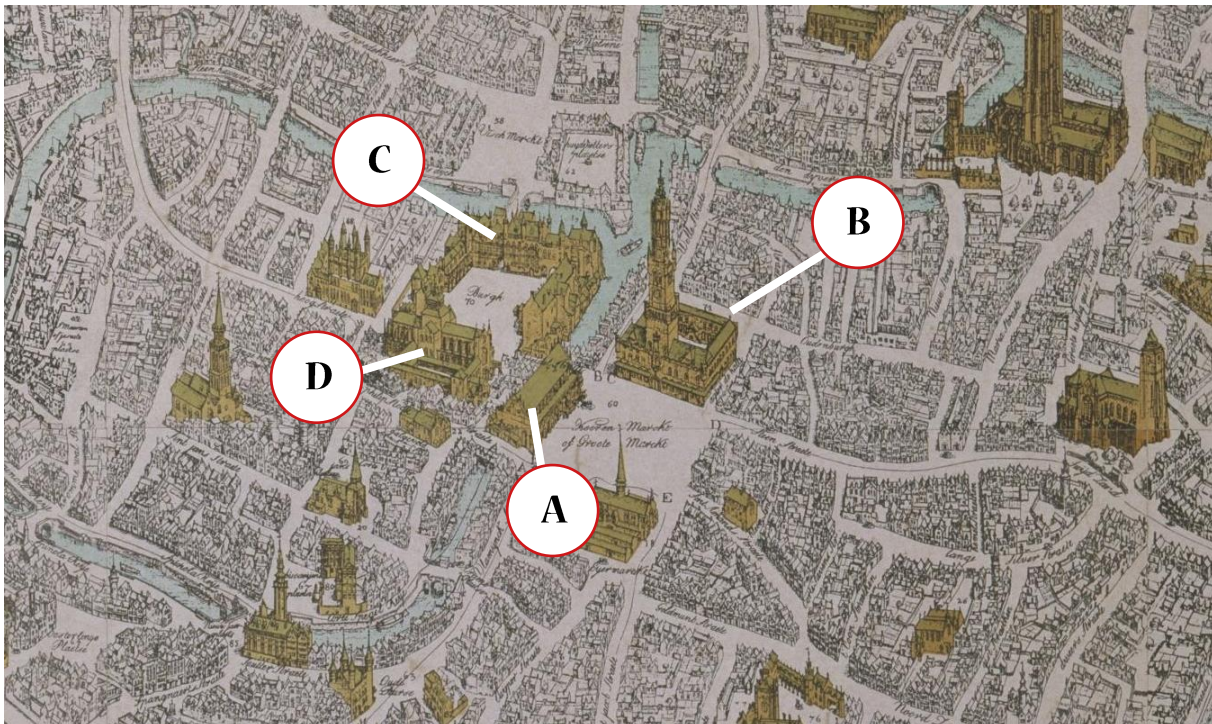

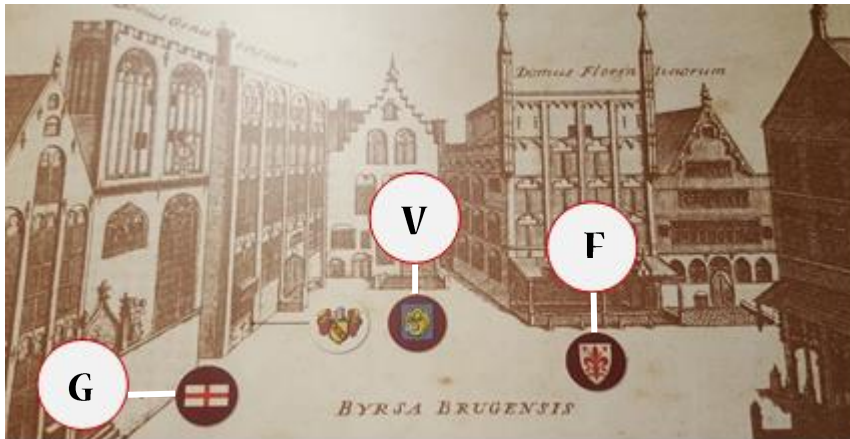
Waterhalle (A) - Belfry (B) - City Hall (C) - St-Donatian's Church (D)

The people in the picture are helping out in the workshop.

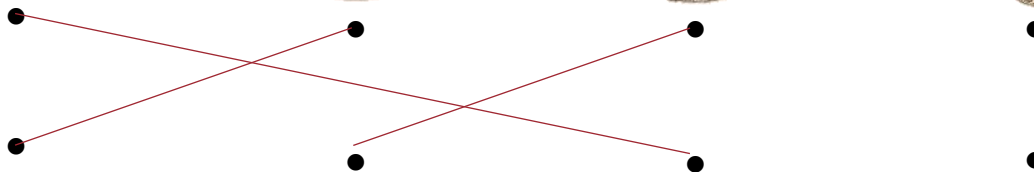
'Ter Beurze' and the "nation houses"

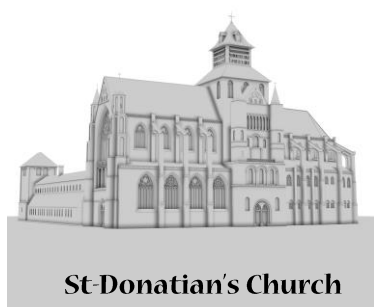
